Mr. Kraus made motion to approve Manchester Road's Sewage pumping station Final Plans, Mr Heidler seconded. Unanimous.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Mr. Kraus made motion to award T A Emerick Construction Company to construct a booth at Millfair Compost & Recycling Center in the amount of \$ 15,489.00, Mr. Heidler seconded. Unanimous.

The Supervisors unanimously approved BIU's proposal for professional services on motion by Mr. Kraus, seconded by Mr. Heidler.

**SUPERVISORS' REPORT:**

Mr. Kraus reported the bathroom at Avonia Beach House is almost complete. Mr. Heidler reported the street sweeping has begun of course depending on Mother Nature. Close to going out for pavement bids.
