The regular meeting of the Supervisors of Fairview Township was called to order at 7:00 P.M. on February 7, 2013 by Chairman Peter D. Kraus, followed with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**PUBLIC HEARING TO APPROVE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN FAIRVIEW TOWNSHIP AND FAIRVIEW SCHOOL DISTRICT:**

The regular meeting was closed and the hearing opened at 7:01 P.M. on motion by Mr. Carner, seconded by Mr. Heidler. Unanimous.

The Court Stenographer recorded all comments from the public and the hearing was closed at 7:06 P.M. on motion by Mr. Kraus, seconded by Mr. Heidler. Unanimous.

The Supervisors unanimously approved Ordinance No. 2013-1 authorizing the Township of Fairview to join with the Fairview School District in an Intergovernmental Agreement on motion by Mr. Heidler, seconded by Mr. Carner.

**CITIZENS CONCERNS/INQUIRIES:**

Mr. Richard Enstrom, 7273 Rupert Dr, is complaining about his neighbor snow blowing snow onto his property, hitting his house. He has called the Police in the past and they did nothing. Mr. Enstrom would like an ordinance in the township to prevent this from happening. The Supervisors advised Mr. Enstrom that this is a civil matter and that he can contact the District Justice or call the Police again.

Mr. Jim Carstater delivered the quarterly EMA report. He also discussed the need for an emergency siren for storms. The siren would be tied into the County system and they control when it went off. He recommended that the Township hold a public meeting to discuss this and to educate residents.

**MINUTES:** Minutes of the January 21, 2013 regular meeting and January 23 & January 30, 2013 workshop meeting were approved on motion by Mr. Heidler, seconded by Mr. Carner. Unanimous.

**ENGINEER:**

Mr. Willis reported that Charity Stover is working the PennDOT on the Platz Road bridge and will update us soon

Mr. Willis also reported on the traffic signal at Route 5 & Manchester Road. This signal is getting old and might need to be replaced. At the same time, upgrading it with a pedestrian crossing for the Library. This will also benefit the residents in White Swan Subdivision who are looking for a crosswalk at that intersection.

**PLANNING & ZONING:**

The Supervisors unanimously approved the Gehrlein Subdivision with modification of undersized lot on motion by Mr. Carner, seconded by Mr. Heidler.

**SECRETARY:**

The Supervisors unanimously approved closing the PNC - HOP Account on recommendation of Malin, Bergquist & Co. on motion by Mr. Heidler, seconded by Mr. Carner.

The Supervisors unanimously approved a \$.10 increase per slip collected for the Fairview Township Tax Collector to \$1.70/slip, beginning January 1, 2014, on motion by Mr. Carner, seconded by Mr. Heidler.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The Supervisors will continue to talk with County Conservation District for alternatives to the storm water retention pond issues in Brandy Run Subdivision.

**SUPERVISORS' REPORT:**

Mr. Kraus announced the need to establish a new Damage Assessment Team. Mr. Larry Biggie is the new chairman and will be contacting new members.

Mr. Carner ask the Supervisors for permission to start at 6:45 A.M. and work until 3:15 P.M. He feels that the can better serve the Township by staying the extra 15 minutes to return phone calls and answer questions that arise during the day. Mr. Kraus feels that everyone should have the same set hours. Mr. Heidler made motion, seconded by Mr. Carner to change Mr. Carner's work hours. Mr. Kraus voted no.

Mr. Heidler reported that the Fairview Sewer & Water Authority will be sending out a survey to the residents on Fairfield Dr concerning the sewer extension line and their desire to hook up.

Mr. Heidler asked that the residents please not park on the roads so the plows can do a good job.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Mr. Tom Gido thanked the Supervisors for the good job that the plowers have done on the roads this winter.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 P.M. Motion by Mr. Carner, seconded by Mr. Heidler.
