Workshop Meeting ~ December 9, 2015 ~ 1:00 P.M.

The workshop meeting of the Supervisors of Fairview Township was called to order at 1:00 pm on December 9, 2015 by Chairman Mark Gennuso. Present were: Supervisors Peter Kraus; Ralph Heidler; Township Engineer Andy Holland; Erik Kincade, Ed Barnes, Dave Muye Fairview School District, and Secretary Judy Schroeck.

The group reviewed plans from Urban Engineers for school crossing lights across Route 98 and sidewalks on the school district property. The crossing at Buckingham Place will have signals in the PennDot right-of-way so no easements will be needed. The ditch along Route 98 will be piped for approximately 100 feet in front of the apartments. The sidewalk will be 5 feet wide and continue behind the school district sign and along McCray Road to the school drive and sidewalk. The culvert along McCray Road is close to the road and may possibly be extended by 20 feet to allow the sidewalk to move away from the roadway.

There will be two beacon signals around an existing light pole on the west side of Route 98 and Oakwilde Drive with push buttons for activation. The east side of Route 98 will also have a pole with a push button that will require an eleven square foot area easement from the school district for township maintenance. The sidewalk will continue from there along the east side of Route 98 to an existing sidewalk on the north side of the school district property. Another older sidewalk running back to the bus garage area may need to be removed as part of this project or the school district may address it later.

The sidewalk will continue from Oakwilde Drive and Route 98 east to a flag pole on the school district property, where the existing sidewalk will need to be lowered for handicapped accessibility.

The sidewalk will continue south from the Middle School across their parking lot, and will be kept 2 inches higher than the asphalt, then graded to the parking lot.

The school district's contribution to the project will be approximately \$34,000.00. They would like to proceed with the sidewalk project this summer even if the grant money is not released by then. The school district will get board approval for this at their next school board meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 1:50 pm.
