PUBLIC HEARING TO APPROVE THE ADOPTION OF FAIRVIEW TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE 2014-3 – AUTHORIZING INTER-GOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION WITH THE COUNTY OF ERIE AND OTHER MUNICIPALITIES WITH RESPECT TO ACQUISITION, INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF RADIO-BASED TRAFFIC SYSTEM SIGNAL PREEMPTION INTERSECTION EQUIPMENT TO ASSIST IN TIMELY DELIVERY OF EMERGENCY SERVICES.

The Supervisors unanimously approved the Emergency Vehicle Preemption System Inter-Government Cooperation Agreement (pending the other Municipalities sign the agreement) on motion by Mr. Heidler, seconded by Mr. Gennuso.

ENGINEER:

Mr. Holland reported that Urban Engineers had a field meeting with PennDOT concerning the traffic signal upgrade at Route 5 & Manchester Road and have made some changes. Urban Engineer will get the property easements to Atty Burroughs for his review.

The traffic signal at Route 20 & Manchester will be turned on and tested on March 18, 2014.

Mr. Holland reported that the specs for the storage building are almost ready to go out for bid.

Urban Engineers have received preliminary plans for Brandy Run Phase 4 and will begin reviewing them.

The Supervisors discussed the MS-4 implementation of a stormwater management program for minimizing the impacts from runoff water to meet the new DEP requirements.
