CITIZEN'S CONCERNS/INQUIRIES:

Larry Biggie asked if the Supervisors had been briefed on the disaster siren at Fairview Evergreen Nurseries and the compatibility issues it had with the Erie County system. Mr. Gennuso responded that he recently had a conversation with Fairview Fire & Rescue Chief Evan Baker regarding the problems and that the Supervisors were working on a viable solution.

MINUTES:

PLANNING/ZONING REPORT:

Mr. Heider motioned to approve the annual agreement with the Township's website developer Civic Plus, seconded by Mr. Gennuso. Unanimous.

SUPERVISORS' REPORT:

Mr. Kraus explained that the Supervisors were considering the employees' futures. The Board is exploring retirement options for the employees and will be discussing these options with the Board of Auditors at their annual Meeting on January 7, 2020.

Mr. Gennuso requested Auditor Tony Mitcho discuss with his fellow auditors the option of pushing the meeting start time back 45 minutes to allow him to attend his grandmother's funeral in its entirety.

PUBLIC COMMENT:
