A Cooperative Partnership® is any new partnership formally adopted by two or more participating entities designed to serve a basic public safety need in the community. A Cooperative Partnership can be a merger, consolidation, regionalization or some other combination of administrative and/or operational services used to create a strong and resilient emergency services system.

Why are these being developed?

Volunteer Firefighters in PA:

1970s = 300,000

1990s = 70,000

2000s = 45,000

2018 = 38,000

We lost over 250,000 firemen in 40 years! Or 6,250/year!

By 2025, the trend line shows no more volunteers!

What is the No. 1 goal of a new partnership?

"To create a strong and resilient professional emergency services system for the communities served in a cost-effective manner."

Remember, this is not about selling fire apparatus, ambulances, laying off staff and/or closing fire stations!

If you decide to form a new partnership and develop a new fire and emergency services system, there are four (4) core areas to focus during the partnership planning process!

- 1. Governance and Bylaws
- 2. Budget and Finance
- 3. Operations
- 4. Community Relations
